LAUNCRY-1 cup PUREX per load in top-loading washing machines; 1/2 cup in front loading machines; or 1/2 cup per 2 gallons water. For bleaching and sanitizing white or colorfast cottons, linens, nylon, Dacron, Orlon, rayon use bleach in washing machine or first rinse. Wash or soak 10 minutes. Rinse well, If clothes are already in machine, dilute the bleach with one quart water before using.

CLEANING KITCHEN & BATHROOM - Use 1/2 cup per quart of water. To clean sinks, bathtubs, tile, linoleum, porcelain, enameled metal, etc., spread solution with cloth. Let stand 2 minutes. Rinse well.

TOILET BOWLS-Use 1/2 cup PUREX bleach.

Pour in bleach-swab with brush. Let stand for 10 min. Flush. DO NOT use with bowl cleaners or other household chemicals.

WADING POOLS-Add 3/2 cup PUREX for 100 gallons new water. Mix bleach in two gallons water and spread uniformly over the surface. (Between fillings, add $\frac{1}{28}$ cup bleach per 100 gallons each day.) Small pools should be emptied daily

- 1. Scrape and prewash utensils and glasses whenever possible;
- 2. Wash with a good detergent or compatible cleaner;
- 3. Rinse with clean water;



REMOVING STAINS-Use 1/2 cup PUREX bleach per quart of water. For stubborn stains from fruit, grass, tea, coffee, scorch, ink, mildew, etc., soak stained area in the solution 5 minutes. Rinse well. Repeat if necessary. Colored fabrics-test small piece before using. Use in glass, rubber, porcelain or enameled containers.

WHITENING AGE-YELLOWED NYLON - Use 1/2 cup per quart of water. To whiten nylon that has yellowed with age, soak the fabrics in bleach solution for 10 minutes. Rinse well, Repeat if necessary


DIAPER-PAIL PRE-SOAK -- Use 1/2 cup PUREX per 2 gallons water. First flush out soiled diapers. Then soak in the bleach solution.

DIAPER WASH-Use 1/2 cup PUREX bleach or 2 gallons water. Flush out soiled diapers. Then follow normal laundry procedure.

DRINKING WATER-10 drops PUREX bleach to each gallon of water. To prevent possible bacterial contamination add bleach to water. Mix thoroughly and let stand at least 5 minutes before using.


