As a result of referral to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Herbicide Act (FIFRA), it is acceptable to propose that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. The signal word "Warning" must be immediately below the Child Hazard Warning statement (front panel only).
 - b. Revise the referral statement to read:

See back panel for additional precautionary statements.
 - c. Delete "General Classification."
 - d. Under "To Clean and Disinfect," include:
 - 1) The method of application (e.g., by sponge, mop or spray) or by immersion in solution followed by a statement such as to wet all surfaces thoroughly.

- c. Include the following precautionary statements to read:

Precautionary Statements
Hazards To Humans and Domestic Animals
Warning

Keep Out of Reach of Children. Causes eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

Statement of Practical Treatment

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for a least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. If swallowed, drink and water, saline solution or a large quantity of water. Get medical attention.

Note To Physician

Probable bacterial disease may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.


2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before to release the product for shipment.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR CLEANING ONLY: Use Sentinel for all light to heavy duty cleaning on floors, walls, woodwork, metal door frames, lining cabinets, desks, in hotels, motels, schools.
NORMAL SOIL - Mix 1 part Sentinel with 40-50 parts water. (2.5 to 3 oz. per gallon of water)
HEAVY SOIL - Mix 1 part Sentinel with 20 parts water. (6.5 oz. per gallon of water)
LIGHT SOIL - Mix 1 part Sentinel with 60 parts water. (2 oz. per gallon of water)

TO CLEAN AND DISINFECT: Mix 1 part Sentinel with 20 parts water. Where *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* is suspected of being present use 1 part Sentinel to 5 parts water. (2% oz. per gallon of water).
