Dear Ms. Wagle:

The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with comments:

- . Response to agency letter dated January 10, 2001 for label
- . Updated first aid and storage and disposal statements
- . Add use site funeral home premise
- . Add animal care directions
- . Add contact time for HIV which was left out on the last label

GENERAL COMMENTS

1. As stated on the Agency's letter dated June 27, 2001/Efficacy Report recommendations, the ratio of 1.7 on the label should be changed to 1.5 ratio.
2. The words "Other Ingredients" should be substituted with "Inert Ingredients".
3. Add the following to the "Directions for Use" under Veterinary Practice/Animal Care/Animal Laboratory/Zoos/Pet Shops/Kennels Disinfection":
 - A. Empty all troughs, racks and other feeding and watering appliances.
 - B. Immerse all halters, ropes and other types of equipment used in handling and restraining


animals, as well as forks, shovels and scrapers used for removing liter and manure.

C. Thoroughly scrub all treated feed racks, mangers, troughs, automatic feeders, fountains and waterers with soap or detergent, and rinse with potable water before reuse.

A stamped copy of the accepted labeling is enclosed. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
