WHERE AND HOW TO USE

For cleaning and disinfecting floors, sick rooms, operating rooms, shower and locker rooms, and all areas where soil and bacteria contamination are high, in hospitals, nursing homes, convalescent homes, hotels, motels, schools and office buildings. Recommended for use on conductive floors. Harmless to resilient flooring, tile, terrazzo, painted and varnished surfaces when used as directed. Apply by wiping, mopping, or scrubbing, thoroughly wetting the surface with the recommended use dilution.

PRECAUTIONS

Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Not for use by people who are allergic to synthetic phenols. Wear rubber or vinyl gloves with long gauntlets when pouring from this container and when doing manual cleaning. If Phenomysan itself or its use dilution enters the gloves, immediately remove the gloves and wash hands and wrists with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Replace previous gloves with fresh gloves. Do not reuse previous gloves unless insides are thoroughly cleaned. Severe, sometimes irreversible effects upon the skin can result if wet contact is allowed inside gloves.

RECOMMENDED DILUTIONS

For all general cleaning and disinfection, including tuberculosis areas: 1 gal. water—1½ fl. oz. Phenomysan. Where *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* is suspected of being present, use one part to 15 parts water.

Phosphorus as P—0.63%, as TSP—3.32%
Grams P per recommended use 0.29.

FIRST AID

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If skin irritation occurs, discontinue use of the product. Any irritation which develops should receive prompt medical attention. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.
