SPRAY AND WIPE DISINFECTANT CLEANER

DIRECTIONS

For refilling purposes in spray dispenser bottles.

Pour DUTCH SPRAY and WIPE DISINFECTANT CLEANER from one gallon container into refillable spray bottle. Holding spray bottle 6 - 10 inches away from surface, spray DUTCH onto soiled surface, thoroughly wetting the surface, then wipe off immediately. No rinsing is required.

DUTCH SPRAY and WIPE will remove grease and most stubborn soils from such hard surfaces as: Appliances, bathroom tiles and tubs, chrome fixtures, formica surfaces, kitchen cabinets, porcelain fixtures, painted woodwork and walls, refrigerators and freezers.

WARNING
