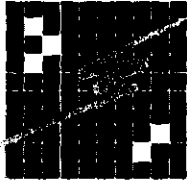

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Hold bottle 6-10 inches away from surface to be cleaned. Spray this product onto soiled surface, thoroughly wetting the surface. Allow to stand 10 minutes, then wipe off. No rinsing is required for non-food contact surfaces. Food contact surfaces must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water.

Institutional Spray and Wipe Dutch[®] Disinfectant Cleaner will remove grease and most stubborn soils from hard non-porous surfaces such as: Appliances, Chrome Fixtures, Formica[®] Surfaces, Kitchen Cabinets, Bathroom Tiles and Tubs, Porcelain Fixtures, Painted Woodwork and Walls, Refrigerators and Freezers.

FOR USE IN FEDERALLY INSPECTED MEAT AND POULTRY PLANTS: For use on all surfaces in inedible product processing areas non-processing areas and/or exterior areas. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. If swallowed, call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If inhaled, move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice. NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.
