**DANGER** KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.  
Harmful if swallowed. May irritate skin, eyes, nose and throat.  
Dust may be harmful if inhaled. Do not take internally. Keep out of  
eyes and off skin. Avoid inhalation of dust. When empty, rinse

Test regularly for pH, chlorine residual and total alkalinity using  
a Guardex test kit.

Never permit chlorine residual to drop below 1.0 ppm. Maintain a  
7.4 - 7.6 pH level and a total alkalinity between 80 - 100 ppm.

**SUPERCHLORINATION** is a good sanitation practice. Use  
Guardex Super Chlorinator and simply follow the use directions  
on the container . . . or use 1 gallon liquid pool chlorine (10-  
14% sodium hypochlorite by weight) per 20,000 gallons pool  
water. If the water temperature is above 75° F, superchlorinate  
once every 2 weeks. If the water temperature is 85° F or higher,  
or a large number of swimmers use the pool, once-a-week super-  
chlorination is desirable. Do not allow swimming in the pool  
until the chlorine residual drops below 2.0 ppm.

**DANGER:** Store in a cool dry, well ventilated area. Mois-  
ture contamination may liberate irritating and hazardous  
chlorine-containing gases. Strong oxidizer, never mix with  
other chemicals or organic matter. A fire or explosion may  
result. Burning will produce chlorine or equally toxic gases.  
This product is toxic to fish. Treated pool water should not  
be discharged where it will drain directly into lakes,  
streams, or ponds.

Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs.

**ANTIDOTE:** Internally--feed bread soaked in milk followed by  
olive oil or cooking oil. Call a physician. **IN CASE OF CON-  
TACT**--remove excess material and flush skin or eyes with cold  
water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, get medical attention.  
Clean contaminated clothing before reuse.
