The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

a. In the "Directions For Use", the solution rates must be given in the standard unit or measures, instead of parts per parts (e.g. ounces per gallons).

b. Delete the A.O.A.C. Use-Dilution Confirmation Test. This is no longer required on the label.

c. Revise the precautionary statements to read:

Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Warning. May cause eye and skin irritation. Do not get on skin, eyes or clothing. Harmful If Swallowed. Not to be taken internally. Avoid contaminatin of food.

2. The requested chemical identity on the inert ingredient "Fast Wool Yellow 3GL" has been reviewed and is acceptable for use in pesticide formulations.

Based on FDA's Memorandum dated May 3, 1995 on "Clarification on Cleaning Agents and General Purpose Disinfectants that require a 510K Submission" it has been determined that your product does not require the FDA/EPA MOU disclaimer statement. Your product is a disinfectant/cleaner intended only for use on environmental surfaces that are not medical devices.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. Submit one (1) copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

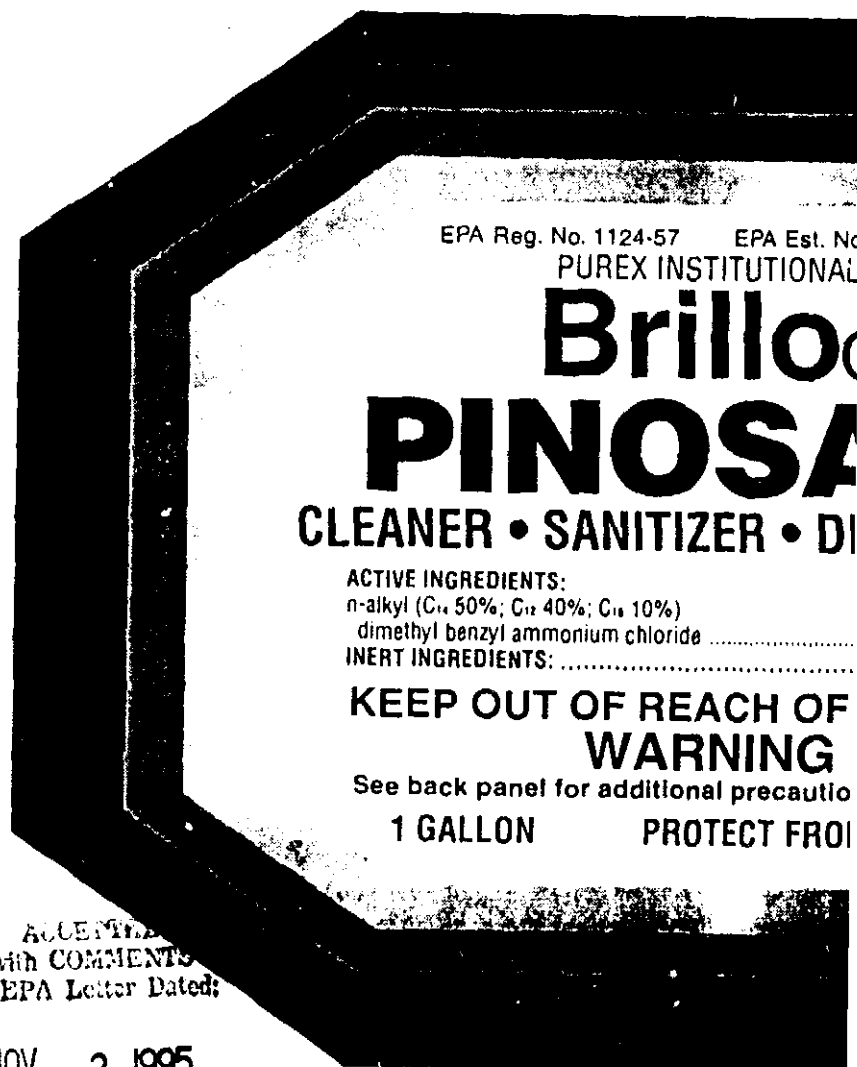
STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR CLEANING ONLY: Use Brillo® PINOSAN® for all light to heavy-duty cleaning on walls, woodwork, floors, in schools, court houses, hospitals, nursing homes, veterinarian clinics, industry, hotels, motels.

NORMAL SOIL: Mix 1 part Brillo PINOSAN with 40-50 parts water.
