DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR CLEANING ONLY: Use Brillo® PINOSAN® for all light to heavy-duty cleaning on walls, woodwork, floors, in schools, court houses, hospitals, nursing homes, veterinarian clinics, industry, hotels, motels.
