BACK PANEL

DURC CLOR is a dry chlorine product which provides 24 hour chlorination with only one daily addition. Its instant dissolving granular form, will not cloud water.

For best results DURC CLOR should be used together with KAL AID chlorine stabilizer to provide the desired long lasting results.

APPLICATION:

The can on this container is a convenient measuring device. One level canful holds 1 ounce of DURC CLOR.

INITIAL TREATMENT:

1- Stabilize pool water immediately by adding 1 pound of KAL AID Chlorine stabilizer per 4000 gallons.

or

2- Stabilize pool water over 3-4 week period by adding a daily dosage of 6 1/2 ounces of DURC CLOR per 10,000 gallons.

SUBSEQUENT TREATMENT:

Daily
The daily dosage is 1 ounce per 1,000 gallons. More frequently be added to maintain a 1-2 ppm residual chlorine.

This product, being a stabilizer, over 10 ppm volatile chlorine is required by law to be labeled "Caution: No swimming." Addition of one canful of DURC CLOR will reduce the chlorine level.

STORAGE:

Keep in a cool, dry place.

Do not use after expiration date.

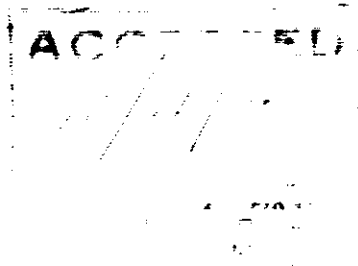
