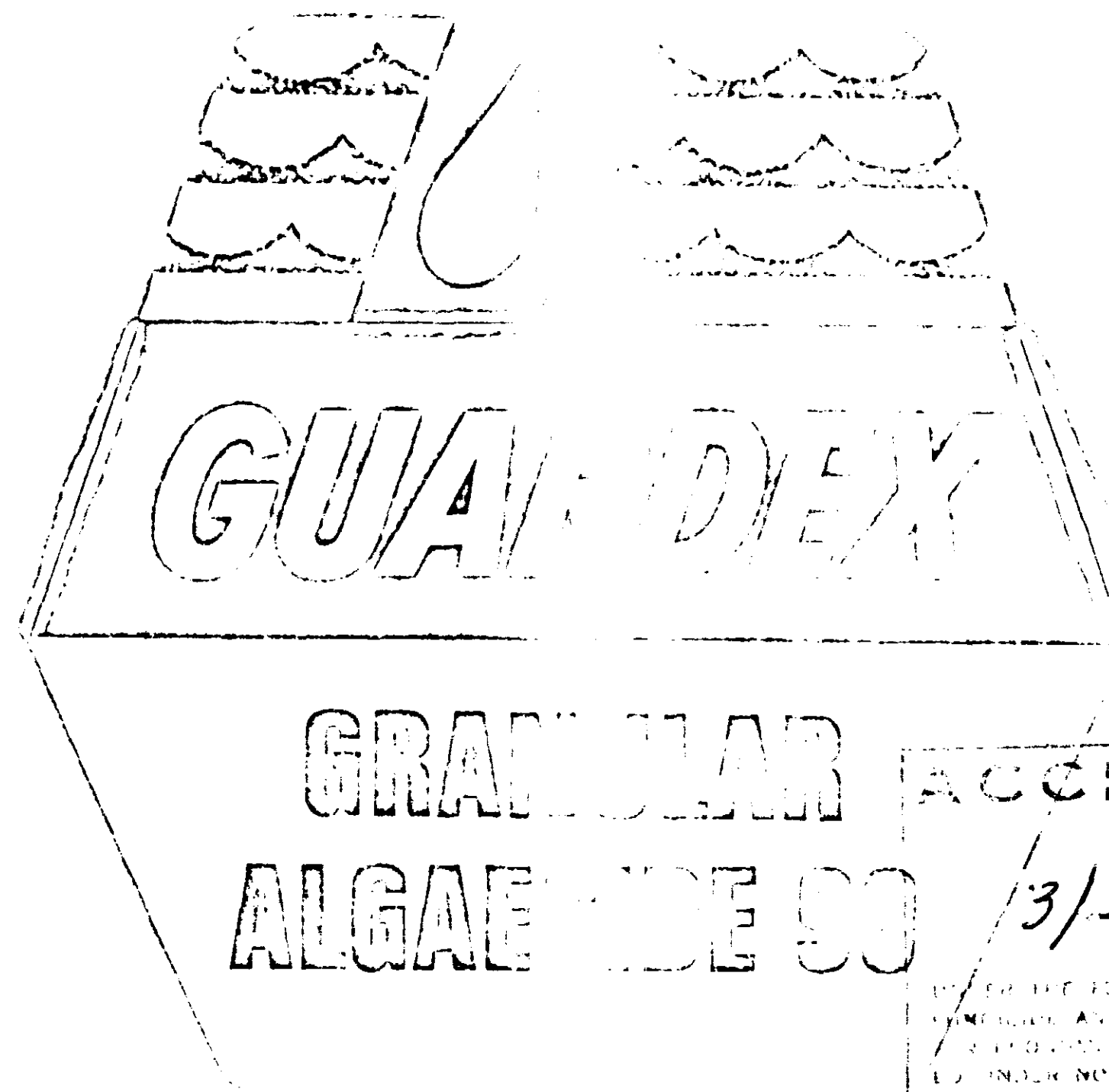

GUARDDEX GRANULAR ALGAE ECIDE 90

Guardex Granular Algaecide 90 is specifically for use on algae which has become attached to the bottom or horizontal surfaces of pool. If algae is the floating type or on the vertical sides of pool use Guardex Algae Control instead.

DIRECTIONS: Before starting treatment adjust total alkalinity to at least 80 ppm and pH to 7.4-7.6. To remove algae which appears on bottom of pool use a brush and rub spots to be removed. Then simply sprinkle Guardex Granular Algaecide 90 on the affected areas. Allow the algaecide to dissolve (2 to 4 hours depending upon water temperature and circulation), then brush affected area with brush. If some spots remain repeat the treatment until algae is gone. Do not exceed 1 to 1.5 ounces per 1000 gallons of water at any time.

Guardex Granular Algaecide dissolves slowly to release concentrated chlorine in the area where applied. Do not allow swimmers in the pool until the granules are completely dissolved and the chlorine residual has dropped to 2.0 ppm. Use a Guardex 4 in 1 Test Kit to determine the chlorine residual.

NOT RECOMMENDED FOR USE IN VINYL LINED POOLS

DANGER: STORE in a cool, dry place. DO NOT bring this chemical in contact with other chemicals. DO NOT use any other chemical in this container or put this chemical in another container. An explosion or fire may result.

This product is toxic to fish. Do not allow treated pool water to drain directly into lakes, streams or ponds.

Rinse container thoroughly with water and discard.

ANTIDOTE: Internally feed bread soaked in milk followed by olive oil or cooking oil. Call a physician. In case of contact—remove excess material and flush skin or eyes with cold water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, get medical attention. Clean contaminated clothing before reuse.

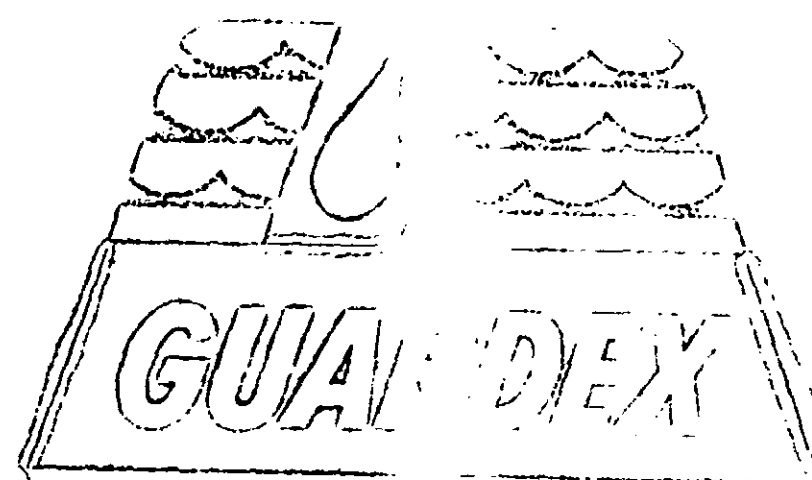
