3. The alternate Name "Blue-Lite" is acceptable.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with labeling.
Cleaning and Disinfecting Toilet Bowls: Remove water from bowl by pushing over trap with bowl mop. Holding bowl mop directly over toilet, pour 4 fl. oz. BLU-LITE onto mop; thoroughly clean all areas and under flush ring. Allow solution to remain on surface for 10 minutes. Flush toilet and rinse out mop.
Cleaning and Disinfecting Urinals: Holding mop directly over urinal, pour 4 fl. oz. BLU-LITE on mop. Immediately scrub all surfaces. Allow solution to remain on surface for 10 minutes. Replace screen and flush urinal. To deodorize, remove trap screen, pour small amount BLU-LITE into drain opening and scrub. Replace screen and flush urinal. Will not harm plumbing or septic tanks. For cleaning stainless steel, aluminum, copper, brass, ceramic, glass, plastic, cement surfaces, tile and grouting on counters and drainboards, use 4 oz. BLU-LITE to a gallon of water, scrub and rinse thoroughly.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
