DIRECTIONS

Apply 1 3/4 ^{oz} BEAN DUST when you first see signs of insect infestation, preferably during morning hours from feeding activity. For best results apply thoroughly to upper and lower leaf surfaces at the rate of 20 pounds per acre. If needed, repeat applications every 7 to 10 days. Apply up to and including the day of harvest. Do not use on treated bean vines to dairy feed animals.
