## How Much to Use:

- 1. Initial Treatment for Prevention of Algae Growth in Clear Pool Water: Use 8 to 12 fl. oz. of Leslie's Algae Control II for every 10,000 gal-lons of water.
- 2. Initial Treatment for Pools with Visible Established Algae: Use 16 to 24 fl. oz. of Leslie's Algae Control II for every 10,000 gallens of water. Remove dead settled algae by vacuuming.

## Method of Application:
