DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DISINFECTING Use 2 oz. to 1 gallon water to kill gram negative odor causing bacteria in toilet, sick room & other non food household surfaces such as floors, walls & tubs (includes pet sleeping areas & garbage cans). All surfaces must be pre-cleaned prior to disinfecting. Apply with sponge, mop or cloth and thoroughly wet all surfaces. Let stand 10 minutes or until air dry. Prepare fresh solution for each use.

CLEANING-DEODORIZING Use Pine-O-Pine for general household cleaning and removing grease. Use full strength to clean and unclog sink drains and to deodorize toilet bowls.
