STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of skin contact, wash with plenty of soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. If product gets in the eyes, flush immediately with copious amounts of clean, cool water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention immediately. If swallowed, call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression, and convulsion may be needed.

DANGER

Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish and wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds. Permits may be required for discharges containing this pesticide into lakes, streams, ponds, or public water. For guidance, contact the regional office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Do not store in areas of excess moisture or humidity. Do not stack more than four drums high. Damaged drums should be placed in overpack drums and disposed of immediately. Spills should be swept up and disposed of as stated below. Dust masks, goggles, and rubber gloves are recommended for workmen handling product. Open drums in well ventilated areas. Keep container tightly closed when not in use. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous.
