INSTRUCTIONS

FOR SARCOPTIC MANGE OR LICE IN HOGS (SPRAY OR DIP).

For young animals (over 3 months of age)—Mix ½ lb. of MoorMaFume with 12 gallons of water and use as a spray or dip.

For mature animals—Mix 1 lb. of MoorMaFume with 12 gallons of water and use as a spray or dip.

The sprayer should be agitated or shaken occasionally during spraying to keep the MoorMaFume in suspension. Spray the hogs thoroughly, making sure all affected areas including the inside of the pig's sars and the underside of its body, are well soaked. One gallon of spray will treat 8 to 10 pigs weighing 100 lbs.

POR HOG LICE (SPRINKLE).

Sprinkle evenly at the rate of 2 cz. to each 50 sq. ft. In the bedding and on all places where hogs sleep. Be sure all the hogs sleep in the treated areas. Allow ventilation but avoid drafts. For a thorough job repeat treatment in two weeks. Do not apply directly to animals.

POR BEEF CATTLE, SHEEP AND GOATS-LICE, TICKS (KEDS), SCAB MITES (SCABIES), SARCOPTIC MANGE AND HORN FLIES (SPRAY OF DIP).

For young animals (over 3 months of age)—Mix ½ lb. of MoorM.zFume with 12 gallons of water and use as a spray or dip.

For mature animals—Mix 1 lb. of MoorMaTume with 12 gallons of water und use as a spray or dip.

Agitate occasionally to maintain a good suspension. Allow one to two qualistation application is generally sufficient. MoorMaFume kills lies eggs as well as the lice themselves by contact. For sarcoptic mange it is only necessary to treat thoroughly the affected areas, but for lice, ticks and scale mites, the entire animal should be thoroughly sprayed or dipped. For horn fly control in beef cattle, the treatment may be repeated every 2 to 3 weeks if necessary.

CAUTION. Do not treat animals under three months of age. Do not treat animals within 30 days of slaughter. Do not dip animals within 60 days of slaughter. Do not treat sows within two weeks of farrowing nor for at least three weeks thereafter. Avoid treating animals in cold, stormy weather. Avoid treating overheated or sick animals.

Do not treat dairy animals or use in dairy barns. Do not use on poultry or in poultry houses.

Do not reuse container. Destroy when empty.
