

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Make sure cattle are not starved for minerals or salt by providing them before feeding ADM Alliance Nutrition IGR Mineral 0.005% Tub. Then remove salt or mineral supplement and place ADM Alliance Nutrition IGR Mineral 0.005% Tub before cattle as the only source of minerals. Start feeding this product continuously in the spring before horn flies appear on cattle and continue feeding until cold weather restricts horn fly activity.

The recommended consumption of ADM Alliance Nutrition IGR Mineral 0.005% Tub is 0.50 lb (1/2 lb) per 100 lbs of body weight per month. Protect this product from the rain.

If consumption of this product is above 0.50 lb (1/2 lb), reduce the number of feeding locations where this product is fed or relocate this product in areas less frequented by cattle.

If consumption of this product is below 0.50 lb (1/2 lb) per day, increase the number of feeding locations where this product is fed or relocate this product in areas more frequented by cattle.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water or food, by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool, dry area.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an
