

Twin Light MALATI ION 4 - DUST is effective for control of the following insects on VEGETAILES, FLOWERS and ORNAMENTALS.

PEGETABLES Use Twin Light Malathion 4% Dust at the rate of 1 pound per 1000 square feet except as noted on the crops shown below, whether dusting or spraying 4.78 PEGGET MESSETT. WE PEGGET.

TOMATOES, PEPPELS, EGGPLANT CUCUMBERS, SQUASH, MELONS: Aphids and Spider Mites. For Lacebugs on EGGPLANT use 2 pounds per 1000 square teet make one or more applications as needed.

NOTE Make no application later than J days before harvest

Do not apply to Cucurbits unless plants are dry

COLE CROPS: Applied Implied Cabbage Worms and Cabbage Loopers.

Make one or more applications as neededen BROSSE A.F. CABBAGE CAN HEADY

bEANS Mexican Boan Beetle and Spider Mites. Make two or more applications as needed.

POTATOES: Aphid Make one or more applications as needed.

PEAS: Pea Aphid. Make one or more applications as needed.

NOTE: Make no applications on Beans, Potatoes and Peas later than 3 days before harves:

Make no applications on Cole Crops later than 7 days before harvest, proceeds no later than 3 days.

STRAWBERRIES: Spider Mites. Apply when mites appear, repeat as needed. BLUEBERRIES: Maggot. Make applications at 10 day intervals as long as harvest continues.

NOTE: Make no application on strawberries later than 3 days before harvest, 1 day for blueberries.

FLOWERS: Aphids, Spider Mites, Japanese Beetles, Rose Legfhopper, Leaf Rollers, Fourlined Leaf Bug, Mealybugs, Tarnished Plant Bug, Thrips, Whitefly on ROSES, GLADICLUS, DAHLIAS, SWEET PEAS, ASTERS and CHRYSANTHE-MUMS.

ORNAMENTALS: Japanese Beetles, Aphids, Spider Mites, Lacebugs, Azalea Scale, Scurfy Scale, Euonymus Scale, Soft Brown Scale, Bagworms and Boxwood Leaf Miners on AZALEAS, RHODODENDRONS, ARBORVITAE, JUNIPERS, HYDRANGEAS, EUONYMUS, PIERIS, JAPONICA, LILAC and BOXWOOD.

NOTE: For Scale Insects and Bagworms on Shrubs, make only dusting applications. Do not spray for control of these insects as 2 to 3 times the normal dosage of this product is required per gallon of water. This would result in excessive clogging of spray nozzles.

## **DIRECTIONS**

DUSTING - Apply to Vegetables, Flowers and Ornamentals before insects become numerous. Protect Plants through the growing season by dusting at 7 to 14 day intervals and after heavy rains. Cover foliage thoroughly, but do not use in excess. Pay particular attention to cover underside of leaves. SPRAYING \* Add the required amount of material to water and stir thoroughly. Pour the mixture into the sprayer and agitate while spraying in order to obtain a thorough and even coverage. In a small sprayer, shake often for agitation.

DILUTIONS - 6 - 7 level tablespoons per gallon of water. One pound per 8 gallons of water, Washington 100 yellons of water to cover 1000 Lg. Ft., 1150 Sg. Ft. on PEPPERS. CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed.

Avoid prolonged breathing of dust or spray mist.

Avoid repeated or prolonged contact with skin. Wash thoroughly.

Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.
