Use Chlordane in a 2% water emulsion by diluting 2 quarts of Twin Light CHLORDANE 45% SPRAY with 25 Gallons of water.

Dig a trench along the outside of the foundations walls. In brick of hollow block or concrete foundations, dig a trench to, but not below, the footing. Then as the trench is refilled, treat the soil at the rate of 4 gallons per 10 linear feet for each foot of depth. A trench 3 feet deep would require 12 gallons per 10 linear feet. The objective is to establish a treated soil barrier which will prevent termite entry. Other critical areas may also require treatment. It is suggested that you consult the State Extension Service for advice.

CAUTION: This concentrate, if brought into contact with the skin can cause toxic symptoms. Avoid skin contact and inhalation. In case of spillage on skin, wash immediately with soap and water. Avoid contamination of feed, food containers and foodstuffs. Do not use on household pets or humans. Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children. BUILDINGS HAVING BASEMENTS OR CRAWL SPACES

Do not use in poultry houses.

After the Chlordane has been applied, keep children and pets away from the treated areas until the insecticide has soaked well into the soil.

Inspect foundation annually for reinfestation.
