APPROXIMATE SPREADER SETTINGS CYCLONE

Pounds per 1000 sq. ft. $3\frac{2}{1/2}$

The age, condition of spreader, speed of operation and roughness of lawn will cause variations in rates applied. These suggested spreader settings are for your guidance only.

CHINCH BUGS; SOD WEBWORMS, ANTS, EARWIGS, CRICKETS, CUTWORMS, BROWN DOG TICKS and SOWBUGS (PILLBUGS). Spread uniformly at a rate of 1 pound per 1,000 sq. ft. In northeastern states, make first application in May or June or when insects first appear. Re-treat as needed, usually in July or August
Consult your Extension Service Specialist as to exact timing of applications.

HYPERODES WEEVIL: Apply uniformly at a rate of 2 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. Make the first application of suspected area in mid-April followed by second application 30 days later. JAPANESE BEETLE GRUBS and EUROPEAN CHAFER GRUBS.

Depending on infestation, apply uniformly at a rate of 2 to 4 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. For Grub control, apply anytime between late July and

early October when grubs are young and feeding near surface. After application sprinkle the lawn thoroughly to wash the insecticide off the grass and on to the turf

(Wash granules into soil with 30 gallons of water per 1,000 sq. ft.)

WARNING
