

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND
DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin. In case of contact, immediately flush skin with plenty of water.

Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, storage and serving areas. In the home, in food processing areas, and in areas where food is prepared, use only in areas that are not used for food preparation or storage. Thoroughly wash hands after use.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, ponds, or streams. Do not contaminate water by draining of disposal of wastes.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Contains under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or otherwise damage container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

SHAKE BEFORE USE

HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT

APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS

INDOORS

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Gnats and Wasps: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy killed insects.

To Kill Cockroaches, Ants and Crickets: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces, under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, and trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Carpet Beetles: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both under and behind of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Exposed Forms of Jobbed Floor Beetles: Saw-toothed Grain Beetles and Rice Weevils: Find and destroy selected package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Sawflies, Centipedes, Firebrats and Solder: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators.

To Kill Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks: Remove and destroy and pet bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets. Around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and other areas of floor. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried. Allow fresh dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area.

OUTDOORS

To Reduce Infestation of Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Gnats and Small Flying Moths: Spray area affected with these flying insects. Hold container 18-24 inches from shrubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at the rate of 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard of space while moving away from the treated area. To reduce annoyance from these pests, treat open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Ornamental Plant Pests: Eastern Tent Caterpillar, Aerial Silkworms, Leafminers, Looperworms, White Moths, Spider Mites, Japanese Beetles, Sawflies, Aphids and Caterpillars, which may be found on Ornamental Cherry, Spirea, Rose, Caneberry, Ornamental Crabapple, Amelanchier, Azalea, Chrysanthemum, Geranium, Purple Hydrangea, Viburnum, Forsythia, Camellia and Arbutus, spray directly on insects. Caution should be taken when spraying near tender growth on young plants. WHEN SPRAYING, HOLD CAN 18-24 INCHES FROM PLANT.

For best results, spray in the evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Mist the plants lightly. Use a slow sweeping motion. Avoid wetting foliage with spray. Spray roots at the rate of 1 foot per second. For heavy growth, spray both sides of the tree. Repeat as needed. Do not spray when temperatures exceed 90°F.
