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GENERAL INFORMATION

PREPARING THE SPRAY: Fill the spray tank with half the required amount of water or water-free diesel oil, fuel oil, or kerosene, add the recommended amount of MIDLAND LOW VOLATILE 50-50 BRUSH KILLER emulsifiable concentrate with agitation, and continue filling the spray tank with water or petroleum oil. In straight oil mixtures do not let water get into MIDLAND LOW VOLATILE 50-50 BRUSH KILLER itself or into the finished product. Agitate thoroughly before and during applications.

TREATING SMALL AREAS: One tablespoonful of MIDLAND LOW VOLATILE 50-50 BRUSH KILLER in 1½ gallons of water is about equal to 1 quart in 100 gallons of water.

CAUTION

Avoid spray drift to susceptible plants such as cotton, tomatoes, flowers, grapes, fruit trees, and ornamentals. Spray drift may cause severe injury to both growing and dormant plants. Coarse sprays are less likely to drift. This spray may cause injury to bent grass, St. Augustine grass and clovers. Although this ester is much less volatile than butyl or isopropyl esters, high temperatures may produce vapors, after application which might injure some susceptible plants growing nearby.

DO NOT contaminate irrigation ditches or water for domestic purposes.

DO NOT use the same spray equipment for applying other materials to plants, as injury will result.

DO NOT store near fertilizers, seed, insecticides, fungicides, or rodenticides.

DO NOT use around the home or recreation areas. This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds. Apply the product only as specified on the label. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

DO NOT use near a spill, or store near a heat or open flame.

DO NOT use in poultry. Do not use in poultry. 30 and 55 gallon drums may be returned for reconditioning.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

MIDLAND LOW VOLATILE 50-50 BRUSH KILLER is recommended for the control of herbaceous and woody plants, growing in rangeland, pasture, fence rows, and right-of-ways, such as alder, aspen, birch, brambles (raspberry and blackberry), chokecherry, elder, elderberry, elm, hawthorn, hickory, honeysuckle, locust, oaks, poison ivy, poison oak, salmon berry, sassafras, sumac, wild cherry, wild grape, wild rose, and other species.

FOR FOLIAGE: Use 3 to 4 quarts of MIDLAND LOW VOLATILE 50-50 BRUSH KILLER in 100 gallons of water for woody growth up to 6 or 8 feet tall. Spray all parts of the plants, thoroughly wetting foliage, shoot stems, and bark. To obtain best results, apply in spring after foliage is well developed; however, applications may be made up to 30 days before frost. One application per year is usually sufficient. As new growth appears, repeat treatments may be necessary. When applied on rangeland or pasture, do not use more than 1½ gallons of MIDLAND LOW VOLATILE 50-50 BRUSH KILLER per acre.

FOR BASAL BARK: Use 1 to 2 gallons of MIDLAND LOW VOLATILE 50-50 BRUSH KILLER with sufficient diesel oil, fuel oil, or kerosene to make 25 gallons. Spray the basal parts of brush stems and small tree trunks to a height of 12 to 20 inches from the ground, completely wetting the indicated area particularly at the ground line. Application may be made at any time of year. Young or smooth bark will not require as much spray as old or rough bark. Do not cut treated brush or trees for one year after application. When applied on rangeland or pasture, do not use more than 1½ gallons of MIDLAND LOW VOLATILE 50-50 BRUSH KILLER per acre.

FOR STUMPS: Use 1 gallon of MIDLAND LOW VOLATILE 50-50 BRUSH KILLER with sufficient diesel oil, fuel oil, or kerosene to make 25 gallons. Cut growth of more than 6 or 8 feet tall close to the ground and spray stumps and stubs, wetting thoroughly cut surfaces and exposed bark, preferably immediately after cutting. Application may be made at any time of year.

FRILL TREATMENT: For trees 6 inches in diameter or larger, use the frill or notch treatment. Cut a wedge, back girdle or overlapping axe cuts completely around the tree near the ground line. Treat the injured area with a solution of 2 quarts of MIDLAND LOW VOLATILE 50-50 BRUSH KILLER in 25 gallons of diesel oil, fuel oil, or kerosene (1/2 pint in 5 gallons).

FOR RANGELAND AND PASTURE: Do not use more than 1½ gallons MIDLAND LOW VOLATILE 50-50 BRUSH KILLER per acre. Do not graze treated areas by dairy animals within 6 weeks after treatment. Do not graze meat animals or treated areas within 2 weeks of slaughter. Do not apply to new or second crop. Do not treat grasses from early boot to milk stage, or when dairy and production is desired.
