

# 1180-41 DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- To develop a residual repellency to stable flies, horn flies, house flies, mosquitoes and gnats on dairy cows, apply 1 to 2 ounces of MIDLAND R-326 STOCK SPRAY, containing Pyrethrum and COWTENT REPELLENT to each animal for a period of three days. There are 16 fluid ounces in a pint. Do not exceed 2 ounces per animal per day. Spray in the same manner again after two days have elapsed, and every second day thereafter, or when insects again disturb the animal. Apply a fine, light mist from a distance of 2 feet, permitting the spray particles to collect upon the hair. Give special attention to shoulders, belly and legs. Wash teats and udder with an approved cleansing solution prior to milking.
- For space spraying to kill flies, mosquitoes and gnats, close doors and windows and direct the spray toward the ceiling, making sure all areas are thoroughly sprayed. The room should remain closed for 15 minutes. Sweep up the fallen insects and destroy them. Repeat as necessary.
