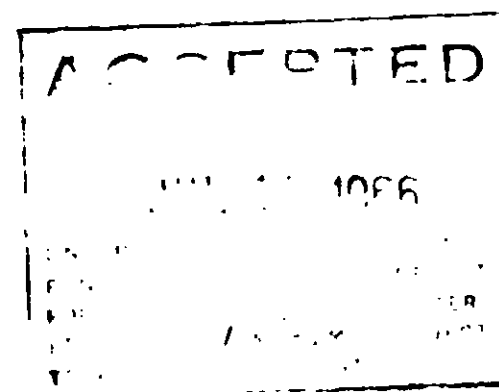

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

VIRGINIA ALGAE-CIDE NO. 5 is a solution which combines an
Organo-Metallic compound and a quaternary ammonium compound
to provide much greater control of biological growths than
either compound used independently. VIRGINIA ALGAE-CIDE NO. 5
is specifically recommended for the control of algae and slime
growths in evaporative cooling water systems.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Add 1.5 to 3 fluid ounces of VIRGINIA ALGAE-CIDE NO. 5 for
each 100 gallons (or about 1 to 2 pints per 1000 gallons) of
water in the system while circulating the water. For maximum
benefit, stop bleed-off overnight following treatment addition.
Repeat treatment as often as necessary--depending upon the
extent of growth and the rate of new growth. Consistent use
will provide maximum results. For continuous treatment after
initial "slug" dosage, feed at a rate of 1 to 3 ounces per
1000 gallons of total bleed-off. Take adequate measures to
prevent clogging of strainers when heavy growths are dislodged.
Heavy growths should be physically removed from the system before
adding treatment.

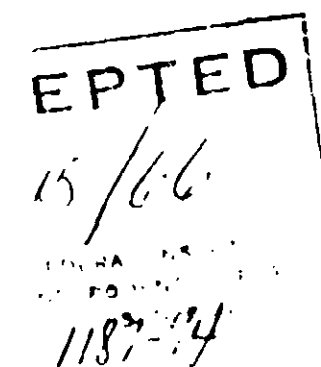
