### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

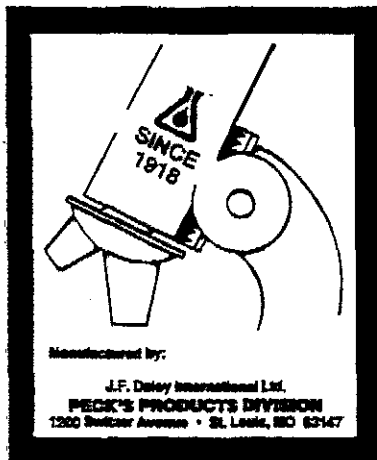
It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**FOR DISINFECTING** in Hospitals, Nursing Homes, Public Rooms: After cleaning, apply solution containing 1 ounce disinfectant to 2 gallons of water. Thoroughly wet all surfaces by use of mop, sponge or spray or by complete immersion. Surfaces in hospitals and medical type environments, as well as barber instruments, should be treated with a solution of 1 ounce disinfectant per gallon of water. At 1 ounce per gallon this product is effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*. For either use, allow surface to remain wet for 10 minutes. Prepare a fresh solution daily or more often if it becomes diluted or soiled. **DO NOT** reuse disinfecting solution or use for other purposes such as cleaning.

**FOR SANITIZING** food and meat processing equipment, dairy equipment, dishes, silverware, glassware, cooking utensils, sink and counter tops, as well as other hard surfaces: Remove gross food particles and soil by a pre-flush, pre-scrape or pre-soak treatment. Wash surfaces with a good compatible cleaner followed by a potable water rinse prior to sanitizing. Prepare a solution containing 1 ounce of this product in 4 gallons of water. This provides 195 ppm of active quaternary ammonium compound. Apply this solution on surfaces by use of mop, sponge, or spray or by complete immersion. Allow surface to remain wet for at least 7 minutes. Drain excess solution and air dry. Prepare a fresh solution daily or more often if it becomes diluted or soiled. **DO NOT** reuse this solution for sanitizing or use it for other purposes such as cleaning. The udders, flanks and teats of dairy cows can be sanitized by washing with a solution of 1 ounce per 4 gallons of warm water. Use a fresh towel for each cow and avoid contamination of sanitizing solution by dirt and soil.

**MOLD CONTROL** on walls, ceilings and in food plants: Clean surfaces thoroughly. Rinse, then spray or sponge with a solution containing 1 ounce disinfectant to 2 gallons of water.
