The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the following labeling changes below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
 - a. Delete the letter "s" from the statement: Active Ingredients, since only one active is declared.
 - b. The statements: Inert Ingredients and Total Ingredients should be transposed. NOTE: Inert Ingredients is not 100.00 %
 - c. Delete the statement: For sale for use and storage by maintenance personnel only.
 - d. The signal word: Danger should be a separate label element and centered directly under the heading: Keep out of reach of children.
 - e. Delete the statement: Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

f. Delete the heading: General Classification

g. Delete the following words:

concentrated
proven
powerful

h. Refer to th PR NOTICE 83-3 for appropriate pesticide disposal statements.

i. Add the following precautionary statement to the left panel:
Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

j. In the hospital disinfection section and the general disinfection section, include a statement which indicates if and how the product should be removed from the surfaces after the recommended exposure time of 10 minutes.

2. A release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

3. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

DANGER

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg white, gelatin solution; or if these are not available, drink large quantities of milk. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

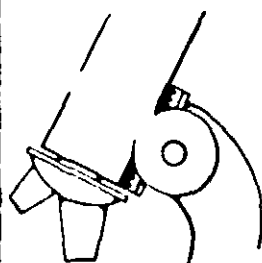
