

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For Cleaning — First remove gross dirt and heavy soil deposits.

LIGHTLY SOILED AREAS — Surfaces to be cleaned should be mopped or brushed with a solution containing 1 ounce per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned area with fresh water.

 - b. The statement "Keep Out of Reach of Children" must be placed directly above the signal word "DANGER."
 - c. Delete the word "Milk."
 - d. Delete "Essential Oils" from the active ingredients and place in the inert ingredients. Change your inert ingredient percentage accordingly.
 - e. Revise the "Use Directions" heading to "Directions for Use," and add the misuse statement immediately below to read:



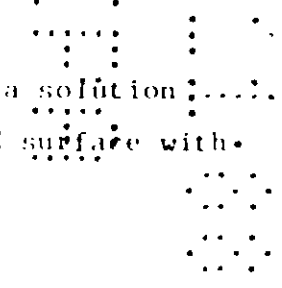

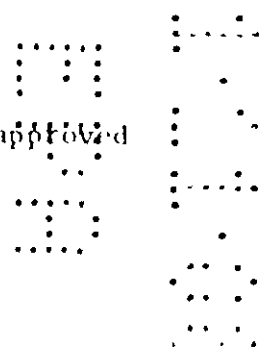
