 Your Amendment Dated: November, 17, 1997

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA sec. 3 (c) (7) (A), will be acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended label.

1) In the section titled "Statement of Practical Treatment" change the sentence which reads "For eyes call a physician." to read "Call a physician." Change the statement which reads "If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk...a large quantity of water." To read "IF SWALLOWED do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, raw egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not readily available, drink a large quantity of water."

2) The last stamped accepted label is dated November 18, 1982. Since there have been changes in the wording for Tox II for eye and skin and Tox III for inhalation since 1982, your proposed label needs to be brought up to current standards. Under the heading "Precautionary Statements" and following the word "WARNING" revise the text as follows: "Causes skin irritation and substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear protective eyewear (goggles, face shield, or safety glasses). Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Harmful if inhaled. Avoid breathing spray mist. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse." The Environmental Hazards statements on both proposed labels (less than 5 gallons and all size containers) are acceptable.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Submit one (1) copy of the final printed label prior to the release of the product for shipment.

Under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, for the product registered under EPA Reg. No. 1190-47.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Select the proper dilution of this product for your use from the directions below. Apply the use solution with a clean mop, sponge, cloth, squeegee or mechanical scrubber or mechanical spraying device. Prepare fresh use solution daily. Do not reuse solutions. Discard solutions when they become visibly soiled. For disinfection, thoroughly wet the surfaces to be treated. Surfaces must remain moist for at least 10 minutes to assure proper germicidal action. If desired, surfaces may be rinsed with clean water or wiped with a clean, damp cloth to remove suspended soils. This product may be used for cleaning and disinfecting hard, non-porous, inanimate environmental surfaces (glass, metal, glazed porcelain, linoleum, tile, smooth leather, vinyl, enameled and finished wood surfaces) on walls, floors, appliances and furnishings.

CLEANING

To clean and deodorize or to pre-clean prior to disinfection: Depending on the soil level of the area to be cleaned, use 8 to 16 oz. of this product per gallon of water.

DISINFECTING

Hospitals, Veterinary Clinics, Nursing Homes, and Other Medically related uses: Use 1 part of this product per 22 parts of water (5 1/2 oz./gal.) for one-step cleaning and disinfection of areas with light to medium soil loads. For heavily soiled areas, pre-clean as described above and then disinfect with this product at 1 part to 31 parts water (4 oz./gal.).

Industrial Areas, Barber Shops, Restrooms, Restaurants, Food and Meat Processing Plants (non-food processing areas), Public Rooms, other non-medical uses: Pre-clean surfaces. Then disinfect with a solution of 1 part of product in 50 parts of water (2 1/2 oz./gal.). Alternatively, clean and disinfect in one operation using 5 1/2 oz. of this product per gallon water.

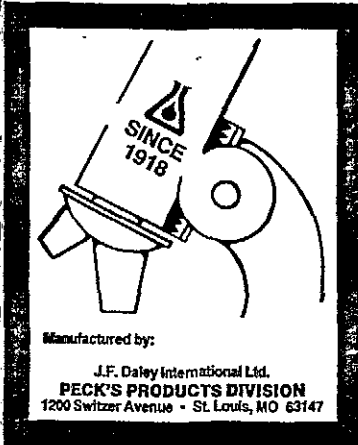
Deodorizing Garbage Cans, Garbage Trucks, Industrial Waste Receptacles, and Garbage Handling Equipment. It is especially important to pre-clean for the product to perform properly. Then, apply a wetting concentration of 12 oz. of this product per gallon of water.

For mildew control: Follow directions for hospital disinfection. Repeat treatment every seven days or when new growth appears.

This product may be used through automatic floor scrubbing equipment. This product must not be used on food contact surfaces.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, raw egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not readily available, drink a large quantity of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

This disinfectant reduces the surface contamination, is capable of mass reproduction, has excellent wettability of this product, that otherwise might not be reached.

This disinfectant is effective against all bacteria. It is also an excellent deodorant, kills bacterial in origin. Has a pleasant odor.

This disinfectant mixes with water and is non-corrosive and non-staining to porous surfaces.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store in plastic containers. **PROHIBITIONS:** DO NOT STORE IN PLACES WHERE CHILDREN CAN ACCESS. DISPOSAL: OPEN DUMPING IS PROHIBITED.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide disposal procedures under Subtitle C of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) apply to this product.
