Dear Mr. Sempkowski,

The following amendment submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable with the following conditions.

- Update First Aid Statements per PR Notice 2001-1

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

1. Qualify "tile" as a hard, nonporous surface by stating "glazed" tile.
2. Under "Disinfecting," revise the last statement to read "Allow surfaces to air dry or wipe excess liquid with a clean cloth." Also, add the statement, "Prepare a fresh solution daily or more often if it becomes diluted or soiled."
3. Since this product may be used in restrooms on glazed porcelain, a consumer may use it to clean and/or disinfect toilet bowls. You either add "toilet bowl exteriors" as a surface to the label or add the following directions:
4. According to PR Notice 83-3, all products are required to have separate storage directions with "Pesticide Storage" as the subheading. Revise the Storage and Disposal directions to reflect the following:

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

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Pesticide Storage: Keep product under locked storage, inaccessible to children or persons unfamiliar with its proper use. Open dumping is prohibited.
Pesticide Disposal and Container Disposal statements are acceptable.

5. Revise the "Precautionary Statements" to read:

Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear protective eyewear (goggles, faceshield, or safety glasses), protective clothing, and rubber gloves. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, or using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

General Comments

A stamped copy of the labeling accepted with conditions is enclosed. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed label before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.

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This disinfectant reduces the surface tension of water, improving its wettability. Microbes are capable of mass reproduction in sub-visible pores, scratches and cracks of surfaces. The exceptional wettability of this product improves the penetration of the use solution into areas that otherwise might not be reached.

This disinfectant is effective against a wide variety of gram-positive and gram-negative bacteria. It is also an excellent deodorant and is especially effective in controlling odors that are bacterial in origin. Has a pleasant mint odor.

This disinfectant mixes with water to form clear, stable use solutions. Use solutions are non-corrosive and non-staining to plastic, vinyl, synthetics, enamel, tile and most common metals.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR RESTROOMS AND GENERAL DISINFECTION of hard, non-porous surfaces (glass, metal, plastic, glazed porcelain, linoleum, tile, leather, vinyl, enamel and finished wood surfaces) on walls, floors, appliances and furnishings in industrial areas.

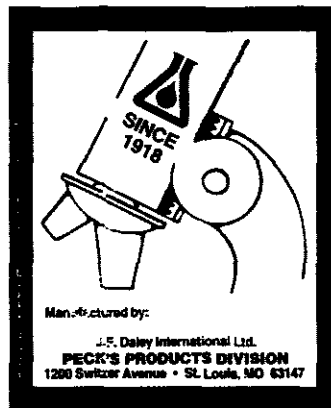
CLEANING: Whenever practical, flush away gross soils with water. For cleaning, use 2 to 8 ounces of this product per gallon of water. Cleaning may be accomplished with a clean mop, sponge, squeegee, wet vacuum system, or a mechanical spraying device. After cleaning, remove suspended soils with a clear water rinse, vacuum pick-up or by wiping with a clean mop, sponge, squeegee or cloth.

DISINFECTING: Before disinfecting, pre-clean surfaces as directed above. Then, prepare 4 ounces of this product per gallon of water and thoroughly wet the surfaces to be disinfected. The disinfecting solution must contact the surface for 10 minutes for proper disinfection. If desired, the surfaces may then be rinsed with clear water or wiped with a clean damp cloth.

FIRST AID:

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing call 911 or ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible.
