Your Submissions Dated July 2, 13 and 20, and August 1, 1990

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Delete the statement "For Sale For Use and Storage By Maintenance Personnel Only."
 - b. Delete the statement "General Classification."
 - c. Delete the word "milk."
2. The revised ingredient statement, changing the carbon chain length distribution of Dioctyl dimethyl ammonium chloride and didecyl dimethyl ammonium chloride so that they would be in agreement with the source product, Bardac 205 M, is acceptable.
3. The submitted chemical identities of the perfumes Baby Powder #50-489; Lemon Pledge Fragrance 131-310; and Coconut #20298, have been reviewed and are acceptable.
4. The Agency still needs the identities of three dyes as stated in our letter of June 8, 1990.
