Retort Cooling Water — For canning operations — add 1 oz iodine sanitizer per 5-10 gallons of retort water prior to starting up operation to control slime and odor causing bacteria

Poultry Drinking Water Sanitization — 1 oz of this product per 10 gallons of drinking water

Shoe Bath Sanitizer — To prevent tracking harmful organisms into animal areas, scrape shoes and place in a 3 oz per gallon solution of this product for 30 seconds prior to entering area
