

HAND SANITIZING — In food handling and meat cutting operations: Rinse hands and immerse in a 1 oz. iodine sanitizer per 5 gallons of water solution (25 ppm titratable iodine).
RETORT COOLING WATER — For canning operations: Add 1 oz. iodine sanitizer per 5-10 gallons of retort water prior to starting up operation to control slime and odor causing bacteria.
POULTRY DRINKING WATER SANITIZATION: 1 oz. of this product per 10 gallons of drinking water.
SHOE BATH SANITIZER: To prevent tracking harmful organisms into animal areas, scrape shoes and place in a 3 oz. per gallon solution of this product for 30 seconds prior to entering area.

DANGER
