DIRECTIONS

Apply powder liberally to body of cat or dog, working in dust by rubbing against the lay of the hair until dust penetrates to skin. Repeat weekly if necessary. Contact ticks with powder.

Do not treat kittens or puppies before a month old.

For kennels and living quarters, dust bedding and floor at rate of 1 ounce per 50 square feet of surface. Repeat as needed.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing of dust. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Avoid contact with skin. Wash hands thoroughly after use.

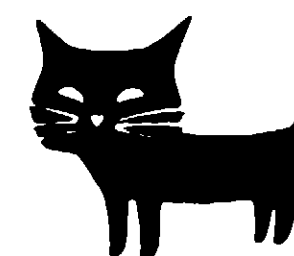
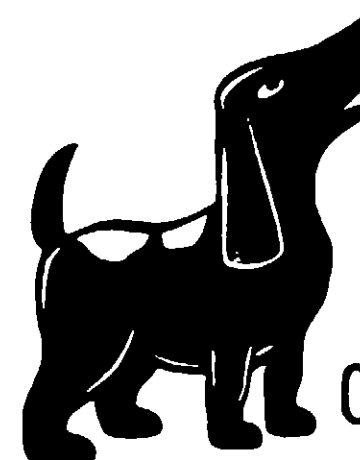
