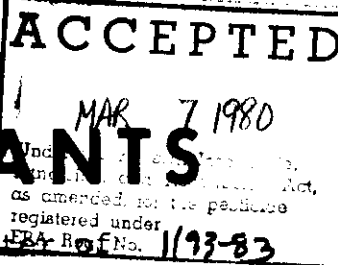

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT.

- If swallowed: Call a physician immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING, unless other treatment is not available. Vomiting can cause aspiration pneumonia. If necessary to induce vomiting, give victim one or two glasses of water and insert finger in back of throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
- If inhaled: Persons affected by spray mist should be removed to fresh air and apply respiration if necessary.
- If on skin: Wash affected parts with soap and cold water.
- If in eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention immediately.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS. HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes.

Do not use in edible products areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

FOR HOUSEHOLD ROACHES, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH: Spray on a spot basis into infested cracks of woodwork, behind pipes, infested areas of baseboards, under linoleum, behind cabinets and pictures and other objects attached to walls. Spray whenever reinfestation re-occurs. Use coarse, wet spray.

DIRECTIONS FOR HOUSEHOLD ANTS: Spray on a spot basis ant trails and areas around windows and doors where ants may enter, also around water pipes, heat ducts, electrical outlets, and baseboards where ants may come out into rooms from wall spaces. Spray whenever infestation re-occurs.

Do not allow spray on asphalt tile, plastics, wallpaper or furniture.
