DIRECTIONS

EAGLE MILL-SPRAY should never be sprinkled — use a sprayer which throws a cloud of fine, fog-like mist. Never use spray in a soiled or rusty sprayer, or in a sprayer partly filled with any other insecticide or substance.

Use of the product should be directed toward the exposed and accessible stages of the Granary Weevil, rice weevil, flour beetle, red rust flour beetle, cadelle, angoumois grain moth, meal worms, and grain mites.

Close doors and windows. Force a heavy mist of spray inside cracks and crevices around water pipes, drains, baseboards, loose wall plaster, etc., where these insects hide. Spray freely towards ceiling in all directions until room is fogged with mist. Return after 5 or 10 minutes, air out room and sweep out the fallen insects. Spray thoroughly each week until insects are gone.

EAGLE MILL-SPRAY is for control of certain insects, pests of mills and warehouses.
