CAUTION:

Pyrenone Insect Spray can be used around food, food products and utensils, but should not be applied directly to food or foodstuffs. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. Container should not be stored above 120 degrees F. Do not puncture or incinerate this container. Keep out of reach of children.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS: For control of these and certain other small flying insects, direct the spray toward the upper portion of the room and saturate the atmosphere with the mist, using 1 to 2 ounces for each 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep doors and windows closed for at least 10 minutes after spraying.

ROACHES, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS, SPIDERS: Spray infested areas thoroughly and direct the liquid behind baseboards, moldings, cabinets, shelves, sinks, door and window frames, pipes, toward drains and dark corners, into cracks and crevices, recesses and similar hiding places.

BEDBUGS: Spray bedframe, springs, mattress tufts and seams. Repeat as necessary.

FLEAS, TICKS: Direct the application toward the lower wall portions, baseboards, rugs and carpets, and floors of infested area. Animals quarters, kennels and bedding should also be sprayed.
