atropine, preferably 1/4 to 1/2 mg. (1/8 to 1/4 grain) every 30 minutes until the patient is fully ataxic. If necessary, repeat 1/4 to 1/2 mg. at once and every 30 minutes thereafter as needed. If the eye and pupil do not dilate, atropine 2 to 4 mg. may be given intravenously. If the heart rate is less than 60 beats per minute, atropine 1 to 2 mg. may be given intravenously. If the patient is still unresponsive, atropine 2 to 4 mg. may be given intravenously.
