

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

RE-ENTRY STATEMENT

rates given in pounds per acre. To be applied by ground duster or aircraft. Application should begin early in the season. Treatments should be repeated hereafter as needed, generally every 7-10 days and continued as permitted by the limitation listed for each crop.

FRUIT AND NUT CROPS:

APPLES, PEARS, CRABAPPLES, QUINCE: 250 lbs scab, cedar-apple rust, black rot, fly speck, sooty blotch, bitter rot, brown rot. Do not apply within 15 days of harvest. Do not graze livestock in treated areas.

GRAPES: (California Only) 50-100 lbs bunch rot, deadarm, early season downy mildew. Do not apply after fruit set.

CRANBERRIES: 60-100 lbs fruit rot. Do not apply within 30 days of harvest.

PAPAYAS: 50-60 lbs anthracnose, phytophthora fruit rot. No time limitation.

FIELD CROPS:

BARLEY, OATS, RYE, WHEAT: 50 lbs. helminthosporium leaf blight, septoria leaf spot. Do not apply within 28 days of harvest. Do not graze livestock in treated area within 28 days after application. Do not apply more than 3 applications in a season.

COTTON: 45-50 lbs rust (Southwest only). Do not apply after bolls are open. Do not graze livestock in treated areas or feed gin trash to livestock.

PEANUTS: 30-35 lbs cercospora leaf spot. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest. Do not feed vine hay to livestock.

VEGETABLE CROPS:

ASPARAGUS: 50 lbs rust. Apply after harvest to ferns only.

CARROTS: 30-50 lbs. cercospora and alternaria leaf spot. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest. Do not use treated tops for food or feed purposes.

CELERY: 50 lbs early blight, late blight. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.

CUCUMBERS, CANTALOUPE, HONEYDEWS, MUSK-MELONS, SUMMER SQUASH, WATERMELONS: 50-75 lbs downy mildew, anthracnose, scab, alternaria leaf spot, cercospora leaf spot, gummy stem blight. No time limitation.

POTATOES: 25-50 lbs late blight, early blight. No time limitation.

TOMATOES: 35-75 lbs late blight, early blight, gray leaf mold, anthracnose. No time limitation.
