Your proposed label changes are acceptable. However, at your next printing of finished labels refer to the enclosed sample label format for restricted use pesticides and make the following revisions:

1. In the Statement of Practical Treatment, remove your First Aid Statement and replace it with: "Call a doctor, clinic or hospital immediately. Explain that the victim has been exposed to parathion and describe his condition."

If swallowed...
If in eyes.....
If on skin.....
If inhaled....."

2. Add to the symptoms statement, "Parathion is a very dangerous poison. It rapidly enters the body on contact with all skin surfaces and eyes. Clothing wet with this material must be removed immediately. Exposed persons must receive prompt medical attention or they may die. See the symptoms of poisoning above."
