## DIMECTIONS FOR USE

Apply by ground rig or aircraft. A thorough application should be made. Do not exceed rate given for each crop.

APPLES, PEACHES, PEARS: Apply 25-150 lbs. per acre to control flea beetle, codling moth, gypsy moth caterpillar, Fuller's rose beetle, plum curculio. Apply at petal fall and every 10 to 14 days thereafter until control is achieved. Remove excess residues by washing, brushing, or other effective means.

**BEANS:** (Dry, Green, Lima, Snap) Apply 25-50 lbs. per acre to control Mexican bean beetle, bean leaf beetle, bean leaf roller, corn earworm, cucumber beetle. Remove excess by washing, brushing, or other effective means.

BROCCOLI, BRUSSELS SPROUTS, 'CABBAGE, CAULIFLOWER, COLLARD, MUSTARD, RADISHES, TURNIPS: Apply 25-100 lbs. per acre to control cabbage looper, climbing cutworm, corn earworm, flea beetle. Do not apply after edible parts start to form on broccoli, brussels sprouts, cabbage. Do not apply after seedling stage on cauliflower, collard, mustard greens, turnips. No time limitation on radishes.

CITRUS: (Grapefruit, Lemons, Limes, Oranges, Taneloes, Tangerines) Apply 25-100 !bs. per acre to control orange tortrix. No time limitation.

CANTALOUPES, MELONS, WATERMELONS, CUCUMBER, SQUASH, PUMPKINS: Apply 25-100 lbs. per acre to control melon worms, pickleworm, cucumber beetle. Remove excess residues by washing, brushing or other effective means.

**PEPPERS:** Apply 15-100 lbs. per acre to control pepper weevil. Remove excess residues by washing, brushing or other effective means.

**STRAWBERRIES:** Apply 25-100 lbs. per acre to control leaf roller. Remove excess residue by washing, brushing or other effective means.
