


DIRECTIONS FOR USE


Apply when air is calm using power dusting equipment or aircraft. For good control make complete coverage of plant surfaces, treating both upper and lower leaf surfaces. Apply when mites first appear and repeat at 7-10 day intervals, or as needed to maintain control, but do not use closer to harvest than specified.

GRAPES:

Apply 20-25 lbs. per acre to control grape leafhoppers, two-spotted mite, Wilamette mite. Do not apply within 15 days of harvest if not dusted more than twice during the fruiting

period.





Apply 25-35 lbs. per acre to control spider mites, lygus bugs. Do not apply after bolls. open. Do not graze dairy or meat animals in treated fields. Workers entering treated fields

within 24 hours following application should wear protective clothing.

Observe limitations given on the label for forage to be fed to dairy animals or animals being finished for slaughter.


