Statement of Practical Treatment

If in contact with clothing: Remove clothing and wash thoroughly. If in contact with food: Wash thoroughly with soap and water. If in contact with feed: Wash thoroughly with soap and water. Note to Physician: Gastric lavage is indicated. Atropine sulfate and 2-PAM are specific antidotes.

Environmental Hazards

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Birds feeding in treated areas may be killed. Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds, tidal marshes, and estuaries (except for effluents from treated watercourses). Do not apply to water that will be used for recreational purposes and human and livestock consumption. Shrimp and crab may be killed at application rates recommended on this label.
