DIRECTIONS

1. Dilute 1/2 ounce of the concentrate with 10 parts of water to one gallon of water. The final strength should be certain to be 1/2 ounce per gallon of water. 2. Apply to the surface to be disinfected.

DISINFECTING:

- 1. Add 1 ounce of the concentrate with 10 parts of water to one gallon of water and agitate.
- 2. Apply to the entire surface by clean mop, brush, or sponge.
- 3. Rinse all treated food contact surfaces with water before reuse.

POULTRY HOUSES AND ANIMAL

- (a) Remove all animal, poultry, lises, cars, beds, trucks, coop.
- (b) Remove all litter and manure and surface of floors, pans, other facilities and fixtures of by animal.
- (c) Empty all troughs, tanks, and watering appliances.
- (d) Saturate all surfaces with recommended dilution.
- (e) Immerse all halters, ropes, equipment used in handling, mules, as well as forks, shovels.
- (f) Wash building floors, boards, and walls of the house, empty equipment until treated, set and dried.
- (g) All feed racks, manger, feeders, buckets, and water supply equipment with detergent before water is reused.

EASY TO USE

DIRECTIONS

1. Clean surfaces to be disinfected. Do not wash when using. If necessary, wash with water. Temperature of water should be between 60° and 100° F. Sweep or vacuum dirt from treated surfaces before applying. Rinse thoroughly with water and dry.

DISINFECTING:

1. Mix one part of the concentrate to one gallon of water, (two parts of water to one part Foremost Pine Oil Disinfectant) and apply.
2. Apply to the entire surface by pouring, spraying or clean mop, brush or sponge.
3. Rinse all treated food contact surfaces with potable water before reuse.

POULTRY HOUSES AND ANIMAL SHELTERS:

- (a) Remove all animals, poultry and feeds from premises, cars, boats, trucks, coops, and crates.
- (b) Remove all litter and manure from floors, walls, and surfaces of barn, pens, stalls, chutes, and other facilities and fixtures occupied or traversed by animals.
- (c) Empty all troughs, racks and other feeding and watering appliances.
- (d) Saturate all surfaces with recommended solution.
- (e) Saturate all halters, ropes and other types of equipment used in handling and restraining animals as well as forks, shovels and scraps.
- (f) Ventilate buildings, cars, boats, coops and other closed spaces. Do not house poultry, livestock or other equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set or dried.
- (g) All treated feed racks, mangers, troughs, automatic feeders, fountains, and waterers must be thoroughly cleaned, decontaminated and rinsed with potable water prior to reuse.
