DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

General—This product is a concentrate to be mixed with water before use it should not be used in conjunction with soap or other amonic detergent. However it is compatible with detergents of cationic or non-ionic type

Industrial areas, Hotels, Motels, Restaurants, other non medical uses: For dismrection of walls, floors, lavatory fixtures.

Surfaces, after cleaning, use a solution containing one of conceptrate to one gallon of water.
