**RESIDUAL:**

**RECOMMENDED:**

Use this product in all areas of public works areas, theaters, schools, hospitals, hotels, restaurants, pet shops, etc. in areas where insects are a problem.

**GENERAL:** Use this product as furnished, without dilution, and follow directions as given for specific insects. Do not apply to areas which will be contacted frequently by children, and do not apply to treated areas until surfaces are dry. Do not contaminate food, water, food containers, cooking utensils or the surfaces of medical instruments. Do not use on clothing or on areas exposed to the weather after treatment in a structure.

For general insect control, use this product in the following areas: *Bed Bugs, Fleas, Mosquitoes, Flies, Ticks, Gnats, Saw-toothed Grains, Grain Beetles, Flour Beetles, Weevils, Warehouse Beetles, Drug Store Beetles, etc.* For Fleas, Ticks, Dog Ticks, Fleas, Carpet Beetles, Carpet Beetles, etc., by means of a coarse spray or paint brush to wash walls, baseboards, etc. boards, under sinks and around, in cracks and crevices, along back of a living, bed, work shelves, and around water pipe openings, around door and window openings and electrical outlets and other areas mentioned by these pests.

The foregoing application will also aid in the control of *Flies, Mosquitoes, Wasps, Gnats, Flying Moths,* and other small flying insects. Additional measures for these pests include treatment of the outside surfaces of doors, screens, windows, around light fixtures, and other surfaces on which such insects appear.

In case of heavy infestations rooms should be thoroughly misted to envelop insects present and then kept closed for 5 to 10 minutes. Afterward, fallen insects may be swept up and discarded.

Application may be repeated as necessary. Food, dishes, utensils, and equipment should be protected from contamination by removal or by covering and washing with clean water and suitable detergent or cleaning agent after the treatment.

**Carpet Beetles and Clothes Moths** - Apply to baseboards, floors (including areas under carpets, along margins of carpets and in closets), behind radiators, and other lint accumulation areas, closet shelves and walls, and infested surface areas of carpeting. Such treatment will control the larval stages of clothes moths in these areas. However, clothing or woolen goods should receive a regular suitable moth-proofing treatment in complete protection. Do not clean all treated articles before using as clothing or bedding.

**Flea and Brown Dog Ticks** in animal quarters may be controlled by liberal application to floors, cracks, crevices and other beetle-frequented areas of kennels, pens, yards, lawns and under houses and kennel animals. Debris and manure should be removed before spraying and the area allowed to dry before returning animals.

Do not treat animals directly. Replace bedding with fresh material after treatment. Repeat in 3 to 4 weeks if necessary.

**APPLICATION WITHIN FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS:**

Limited to crack and crevice treatment only - Apply a pencil thin stream of insecticide directly into cracks and crevices expansion joints between different elements of construction or between equipment bases and the floor. Wall voids, motor housing, junction boxes or switch boxes, conduits or hollow equipment legs where cockroaches, ants, crickets, clover mites, earwigs, silverfish, spiders, antipedes, scorpions, pantry pests, carpet beetles, clothes moths, flees and brown dog ticks hide. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces. Application of this product in the food areas of food handling establishments, other than as a crack and crevice treatment, are not permitted.

**WARNING**

Do not use in edible products areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commonly prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is being served.
