The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, REMOVES THE PRODUCT FROM THE SCOPE OF THE REQUIREMENTS CONTAINED IN 40 CFR PART 156, SUBPART K.

Based on your certification, the Agency has accepted only those changes to your labeling which are necessary to comply with PR Notices 93-7 and 93-11, which reflect the WPS labeling requirements of 40 CFR part 156, subpart K. Any other labeling changes submitted in connection with this amendment application and not directly related to compliance with PR Notice 93-7 or 93-11 have neither been reviewed nor accepted by the Agency. If you wish to make any such changes, you must submit a separate amendment application proposing them. If your product registration is currently suspended, acceptance of this labeling amendment does not affect the suspension in any way.



If used in edible product areas of Federally inspected meat, poultry, shell egg grading and egg product establishments, it must be dispersed as an aerosol spray (no droplets over 50 Microns in diameter and 50% less than 30 microns).

SPACE TREATMENT: Close doors and windows and shut off ventilating systems. Apply as a fog or fine mist, distributing the spray throughout the area. Use at a rate of 1 ounce per 1000 cubic feet of space. Direct spray behind and under obstructions and contact crawling insects whenever possible. Keep area closed for 10 to 15 minutes. Vacate treated area and ventilate before reoccupying. Repeat treatment as necessary. For wasps and hornets, spray late in the evening when insects are at rest.

The above described application will kill accessible exposed stages of house flies, fruit flies, mosquitoes, silverfish, small flying moths, gnats, crickets, cockroaches, spiders, scorpions, weevils, hornets, silver mites, cheese mites, cheese skippers, and these common stored product pests: granary weevils, rice weevils, confused flour beetles, saw-toothed grain beetles, spider beetles, cigarette beetles, drugstore beetles, Angoumois grain moths, Mediterranean flour moths, Indian meal moths, tobacco moths, meal worms, and grain mites.

SURFACE APPLICATION: To insure maximum control of crawling insects listed, apply as a coarse mist directed toward insects, into cracks, crevices, around machinery, around containers of stored products and other areas wherever these insects may hide. Repeat as necessary.
