**EFFECTIVE:** The balanced blend of components assures full effect after application or stage of growth at the time of application. Translocation and root absorption of component herbicides produces extensive root kill of weeds and provides long term residual control.

**ECONOMICAL:** When used according to directions, will provide low cost, convenient and complete weed control.

FIRST AID

**READY TO USE:** Apply anytime of the year except when ground is frozen. Best results are obtained after weeds have emerged and developed. High weeds should be cut down to 3 or 4 inches for maximum penetration to root system for long term kill.

**RECOMMENDED FOR:** Non-crop areas such as fence rows, parking lots, storage yards, tank farms, pipeline, industrial plants and other similar areas.

**APPLICATORS & OTHER HANDLERS MUST WEAR:** Long sleeved shirt and long pants, chemical-resistant gloves made of barrier laminate or viton, and shoes plus socks.

**USER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS:** Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.

**USER SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS:** User should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. User should remove clothing/PPE immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Users should remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing.

**DIRECTIONS**

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. It is ready to use as it comes from the container and no agitation is required. For treating small areas, a tank-type hand sprayer may be used. For larger areas, apply with standard spray equipment.

For control of such annual and perennial weeds as dandelion, Bermuda grass, crabgrass, wild carrot, horse tail, bouncing bet and brackenfern, apply at the rate of three gallons per 1000 sq. feet. Do not apply directly to or permit this product to come in contact with desirable, woody or herbaceous plants or the area where the root may extend. Avoid spray drifts to such plants. Coarse sprays are less likely to drift. Thoroughly clean spray equipment with a suitable chemical cleaner, such as kerosene before using for other purposes or do not use for other purposes.

**GENERAL PRECAUTIONS AND RESTRICTIONS:**

**APPLICATION RESTRICTIONS:** Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. Not to be used in any recreational areas or in or around homes. Aerial application is prohibited.

**ENTRY RESTRICTIONS:** Do not enter or allow others to the treated area until sprays have dried.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Triple rinse (or equivalent) then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved state and local authorities.

**PESTICIDE STORAGE AND SPILL PROCEDURE:** Store upright at room temperature. Do not spill or store near heat or open flame. Do not store near fertilizer, seeds, insecticides or fungicides. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbent material. Dispose of with chemical waste.
