

DIRECTIONS

FOR THE SICK ROOM: Wash all utensils, such as bedpans, urinals, etc., with a solution of three ounces of disinfectant to 1/2 gallon of water.

For **BOILING CLOTHING** and **LINEN** used in sick room: Use in the proportion of three ounces of disinfectant to one gallon of water. Add the water to the disinfectant and mix well before using.

WATER CLOSETS and **URINALS:** Use 3 ounces of disinfectant to a gallon of water. Apply freely to all surfaces to be disinfected and scrub the exposed areas.

For mopping, scrubbing, sprinkling or cleaning: use one-half cup of the disinfectant to two gallons of water.

To deodorize garbage: Sprinkle with solution of one-half cup to a gallon of water. Wash the empty can with some of the solution and leave the wash in can.

FOR GENERAL DISINFECTING

Remove all filth and dirt from the premises and use a solution of one part disinfectant to 100 parts of water. This mixture acts as a disinfectant against *S. Typhosa*.
