CHICKODYNE is a highly effective germicide for use in poultry and meat packing plants. It is a powerful germicide with a strong, germicidal action. CHICKODYNE is effective in killing most common pathogenic bacteria, fungi and viruses. It is highly effective in destroying vegetable contamination and is non-selective in its action. In case of contamination with a rich color of color, just as long as the color remains on the surface, complete and rapid disinfection action is assured. Once this color has disappeared, the solution should be re-treated.

**Directions for use:** For general cleaning and disinfection in a single operation use 6 ounces of CHICKODYNE to 5 gallons of water. Use a scrub brush, rag or mop to insure thorough cleaning. For porous surfaces or those difficult to clean use 2 ounces of CHICKODYNE to 2 gallons of water.

Use 1 ounce of CHICKODYNE to 1 gallon of CHICKODYNE in 4 gallons of water for general cleaning in fresh water. Dip in a solution of 1 ounce CHICKODYNE to 5 gallons of water for at least 2 minutes for the disinfection specified by the governing Sanitary Code. To control as possible contamination of food or other equipment, use a solution until foaming has disappeared. Flush and wash with a solution of 2 ounces of CHICKODYNE to 5 gallons of water for cleaning, sanitizing, and ~~controlling molds on food~~ work. CHICKODYNE is not adversely affected by hard water most commonly encountered. It helps prevent odors and will not stain.
